Course Description

A course designed to extend the student's understanding of cooking systems and related support equipment including a brief introduction to coating and freezing systems. Steam, dry heat, and combination cooking on both linear and spiral ovens are investigated. Char-marking and contact cooking will be explored. The variables of continuous processing are introduced and explained. The relationships among variables are also explored using both real-life examples and data gathered in our Food Processing Technology Center.

Who Should Attend?

This course is particularly suited for food scientists, technical managers, and production personnel who are, or are expected to become involved in fully cooking of food products, including product development, quality assurance, process control and troubleshooting. It will be equally helpful for non-technical managers who need a basic understanding of the technical complexity of the cooking process.

Traveling to Sandusky, Ohio

FROM CLEVELAND HOPKINS AIRPORT.

Follow signs for Route 480 West to Ohio Turnpike (80) West to Exit 135 (Baumhart Road/Vermilion), proceed North on Baumhart Road to Route 2 West. Go West on Route 2 to Rye Beach Road exit. Turn right onto Rye Beach Road. At the traffic light, turn left onto Cleveland Road (SR 6), follow this approximately 5 miles to Causeway Drive (next to the Castaway Bay). Turn right and proceed to the second traffic light (First Street). Turn left; JBT is less than 1/2 mile on the left side.

TOLEDO / DETROIT / OHIO TURNPIKE

I-75 South to Route 280 South. Follow Route 280 to I-80/90 (Ohio Turnpike). Take Turnpike (80/90) East to Exit 118 (Route 250 North) then proceed north on Route 250. You will pass the Sandusky Mall and many hotels and restaurants. Just after passing Perkins Avenue you will come to a bridge overpass, take the Cedar Point ramp to the right. This is Butler Street. Turn right on Cleveland Road and then left on Causeway Drive (next to Thirsty Pony). Proceed to the second traffic light (First Street). Turn left; JBT is less than 1/2 mile on the left.
